Oldham County Foodservice Charge Meal Policy -- Elementary Schools

Charges are designed to cover a situation in which parents or students forget to provide or bring monies for breakfast/lunch. Students who have forgotten or lost money may charge meals in the cafeteria. Under no circumstance may ala carte items be charged. It is the procedure of the cashier to verbally remind the student that their account is low to try to avoid meal charges.

Elementary students may accumulate up to three (3) breakfast/lunch charges. A charge letter with a duplicate charge slip printed from the cash register is sent home on the day of the first and second charge. These letters will be given to the office and sent home with the student that afternoon. On the third charge, the student is discreetly escorted to the managers office and must call their parents to remind them that they have reached the limit of allowed charges and if they do not send money/check the following school day, their child will be given a complimentary peanut butter/jelly sandwich (in the case of an allergy it will be a cheese or bologna sandwich) and a milk. Also on the third charge, a copy of the cash register charge slip is sent to the principal.

A student may have charges on their account but if they have cash to pay for their meal, the cashier must take the money for the meal and then remind the student that they have charges on their account. The cashier may take the change, if any, up to \$10.00 and put it against the charges on the student's account. If all the change is not needed to pay the charges on the account, the cashier will ask the student if they want the balance of the monies to be put on their account or given to them.

Under no circumstances is the student to be embarrassed in front of their peers. The cashier needs to call for the manager or assistant manager and that person will discreetly take the student away from the other students and inform the student on the charge procedures. At the end of the month all uncollected charges are turned over to the principal.

****School lunches provide 1/3 and school breakfasts provide 1/4 of the Daily Recommended Allowances

****Pre-payment of meals is strongly encouraged
In order to close out accounts for the school year, **NO CHARGES** on accounts will be allowed the last two weeks of school.
