On July 14, 2020 the Oldham County Board of Education adopted a temporary policy in response to the COVID-19 pandemic requiring all students to wear face masks while on the bus, at school, or participating in school activities unless they are unable to do so due to a medical condition or disability. Students who are unable to wear a face mask will be required to wear a clear plastic face shield unless they are exempted by a physician due to a medical condition or disability that prevents them from doing so safely. Students exempt from wearing a mask and face shield will be required to maintain 6' of social distance apart from other students while stationary (e.g. in classrooms) and may be required to sit alone during bus transportation

The parent or guardian of the above-named student has requested an exemption from the policy requiring the use of a face mask based on the medical condition or disability of the child. Please verify the following information (*check one or both*):

- The child's medical condition or disability prevents the child from safely wearing a **face mask or similar face covering** while on the bus or while at school.
- The child's medical condition or disability prevents the child from safely wearing a **clear plastic face shield** while on the bus or while at school.
