It is a rigorous, peer-reviewed process that ensures teachers have proven skills to advance student achievement. As part of this process, teachers must analyze their teaching context and students' needs, demonstrate what they have done outside of the classroom to improve student success, submit videos of their teaching, and provide student work samples that demonstrate growth. Additionally, candidates must submit essays describing, analyzing, and reflecting on their practices and the evidence, and pass an exam to demonstrate they have mastered their chosen content area of certification. Just under 3% of the nation's teachers are nationally board certified.
