IX. <u>EXECUTIVE SESSION</u>

The Board needs to go into Executive Session pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(c) to discuss litigation preparation under KRS 61.810(1)(c), the public disclosure of which would jeopardize the Board's position, and the disposition of real property under KRS 61.810(1)(b), the price of which may be affected by public disclosure."

On a motion by Patrick Kehoe, seconded by Walt Schumm, and unanimously carried, the Board went into executive session at 5:13 p.m. (5-0). The Board returned from executive session at 6:30 p.m. with no action to follow.

XI. <u>RECOGNITIONS</u>

Superintendent Schultz, along with Board Vice Chairperson Kevin Woosley, recognized the following students for their outstanding accomplishments:

Oldham County High School band members William Middleton, Chloe Otterback and Khaled Al Asad, for their selection to perform with the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) All National Honors ensembles.

XII. STUDENT SHOWCASE

Students of the Arvin Ed. Center Engineering Program shared on their capstone work for the program thus far.

XIII. <u>SUPERINTENDENT REPORTS</u>

- 1. Brent Bohannon, Director of Facilities Management, provided updates related to ongoing construction projects across the district.
- 2. Michael Williams, Director of Pupil Personnel, presented district enrollment projections for 2019 through 2028, specifically addressing the five-year average projection, which indicates growth for the district by ninety students.

3. Director of Pupil Personnel Michael Williams also presented the proposed plan to rebalance the District's elementary schools, which would be implemented next school year (2019-2020). Mr. Williams, along with district and school administration, conducted four community forums between May 2018 through October 2018, allowing staff, parent and community input in the rebalance process—the same format used when closing Liberty Elementary School. The proposed plan will move 166 elementary students.

g) Chairperson Fletcher, following Superintendent Schultz's recommendation to approve, called for motions. On a motion by Walt Schumm, seconded by Larry Dodson, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized the purchase of six buses (three large-capacity buses three special needs buses) with a total purchase amount of \$668,616.00 (5-0).

XV. PUBLIC EXPRESSION

Chairperson Fletcher announced it was time for public expression. Vice Chairperson Woosley read the Board's public expression policy. The first individual registered to speak declined to comment due to registering in error. The second individual, Rebecca Crowder, made positive comment to the Board on the elementary rebalance process and asked that the district continue to consider intradistrict transfers.

Chairperson Fletcher acknowledged the Board's review of the following information items:

- 1. Monthly Preschool projections, enrollment, and expenditure reports for September 2018.
- 2. Monthly reports on the District's total energy usage and expense.
