CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Oldham County Board of Education believes that activities that compliment instruction are beneficial to students. Therefore, the Board permits schools to implement activities that are unequivocally instructional in nature, are directly related to the instructional program including the District Curriculum Framework, and are scheduled so as to minimize absences from classroom instruction.

The types of co-curricular activities permitted for implementation in the Oldham County Schools are co-op experiences, technology activities, choir, marching band, college visits for seniors, Future Farmers of America, Future Business Leaders of America, Future Homemakers of America, mentoring/shadowing, aiding in the office or library, peer tutoring, study periods, newspaper activities, and other such activities meeting the criteria above and approved by the Superintendent/designee.
