

STUDENT CONTRACT

OCSAC Summer Visual Art Institute 2017

This contract is between the Oldham County Schools Arts Center and _____.

In order to receive one performance based credit for the course Summer Visual Arts Institute I, the student must meet all of the following responsibilities:

-Successfully audition for the institute by submitting a portfolio of 5 pieces of the student's choice. Admission to the class is at the sole discretion of the instructors and is based on artistic merit.

-Attendance at all 10 daily 8 – hour sessions is mandatory. Sessions cancelled due to any emergencies will be rescheduled. The course consists of ten sessions which take place at OCS Arts Center from **July 17 – 28, Monday through Friday from 8:30am-3:30pm**. These sessions are in addition to the student's regular high school course load and take place at a time that is outside of the school calendar. Each daily session includes lessons from 2 instructors, individual coachings, a group project, and open studio or an excursion to a local point of interest. The final Friday of the institute will include a public show at the OCS Arts Center, displaying individual and group art works, for the duration of August, 2017.

-In preparation for each daily session, the student must prepare any assignments given by the instructors so that each day is a productive and effective experience for all involved. As each day is full and varied, sensitivity will be given to the amount of homework assigned.

-Participate in the sessions dedicated to the group project that will be a culminating work of the institute public show. The student agrees to be an active participant, with a positive collaborative attitude.

-Abide by all policies of the SVA Institute as outlined in the Student Handbook.

In providing credit for this course, the Oldham County Schools Arts Center will do the following:

-Provide a *full tuition scholarship for the course if all requirements for credit are successfully met.

**Excludes a mandatory gallery entrance fee and supplies fee of \$60.00.*

- Provide a Pass/Fail grade that will adhere to the OCBE grading scale. This course will not be used in GPA calculation. The grade will be reported to the student's guidance counselor by **Friday, August 11, 2017**. The grade will be reported and the credit posted at the end of the Fall Quarter/Semester of the 2017-2018 school year, provided that all of the above outlined requirements are met.

The student, the parents, the Principal, the OCSAC Executive Director, and one facilitating institute instructor must sign this contract.
