Side by Side is a program from VSA Kentucky that provides a creative outlet for students with disabilities.

Our goal is to reinforce inclusiveness and positive self-image, while highlighting the importance of arts education in the development of our students.

Counties across Kentucky host a wide variety of Side by Side programs. In Oldham County, we're offering:

- A four-week program, open to students with disabilities, who are currently enrolled in Oldham County Schools, in **3rd through 6th grade**.
- **Classes are Saturdays, March 3, 10, 17 and 24**, 10:30 am to 12:00 pm at the Oldham County Schools Arts Center.
- Students will **explore a variety of art mediums**, working in small groups with a general art instructor, *plus* create a final project working side-by-side with a local artist.
- The program is **FREE for qualifying participants**. Space is limited.
- Art created during the Side-by-Side program will be on display at the Oldham County Schools Arts Center during the month of May.
